

Atlanta No. 5 top meeting destination in America

Atlanta is the No. 5 top meeting destination in the United States, according to a new report from [Cvent Inc.](#)

The McLean, Va.-based company (NYSE: CVT) reported it evaluated more than 5,000 U.S. cities featured on the Cvent Supplier Network to compile the fourth annual list.

"Orlando reclaimed the top spot on the 2015 list, a position the city last held in 2013," the company reported. "Las Vegas climbed one spot on the ranking compared to last year, while Chicago dropped two places from number one in 2014 to round out the top three."
